Pupils are free to go home following their allocated time and will return to school on Tuesday 1 September 2026 which will be their first full school day.

The school day begins at 8:20 a.m. and finishes at 3:20 p.m. except on Wednesdays when school finishes at 12:45 p.m.

As we look forward to the new school year, we kindly remind families that students must be in full uniform daily, including the school-crested coat, knee-length skirts, and plain black school shoes (the only exception being the approved all-black Nike Air Force 1). **Please note that students in incorrect uniform will be asked to return home to change.** Additionally, starting this September, our morning routine is changing slightly: **classes will now begin promptly at 8:20am.** We highly recommend students arrive by 8:10am to ensure a smooth, timely start to their first lesson. ## Please Note

- **Full school uniform** must be worn to and from school.
- Only **School Crested Garments** may be worn to and from school.
- Only **School Crested Sportswear** is permitted for P.E. and Sport.
- The School Fleece may be purchased as an optional extra garment
- All items of uniform should be clearly labelled with student's name.
- **Runners are only permitted to be worn with the school tracksuit.**
- **Hoodies and Multi Coloured outer garments are strictly forbidden.**
- Students are not permitted to change into or out of school uniform on arriving or leaving school.
- Hair must adhere to acceptable standards, natural colour only.

*Students are expected to have recourse to spare items of uniform in the event of clothing or footwear being soiled or lost.*
